Shoppers will have their pick of an eclectic mix that includes yardages, yarns, vintage oddments and a wild variety of patterns, quilt fabrics, notions, crafts and books.

We rely on you to make this event a success! Everything in the sale is generously donated. The **More Than Just A Yardage Sale** is an opportunity for fibre enthusiasts to sort through their stashes, contribute to a good cause and make room for new finds.

Donors and donations have ranged from the individual who brought in a few balls of alpaca yarn left over from a project, to the estate of an interior designer who donated a lifetime's collection of decorator samples. If you have something to donate, bring it to the Museum. If it's too big to carry, call 416-599-5321, extension 0, and a volunteer will be happy to arrange a pickup.

Now in its fourteenth year, the **More Than Just A Yardage Sale** is a "must do" event for thrifty Toronto-area textile enthusiasts. The sale has become a major event, raising tens of thousands of dollars and attracting large crowds.
